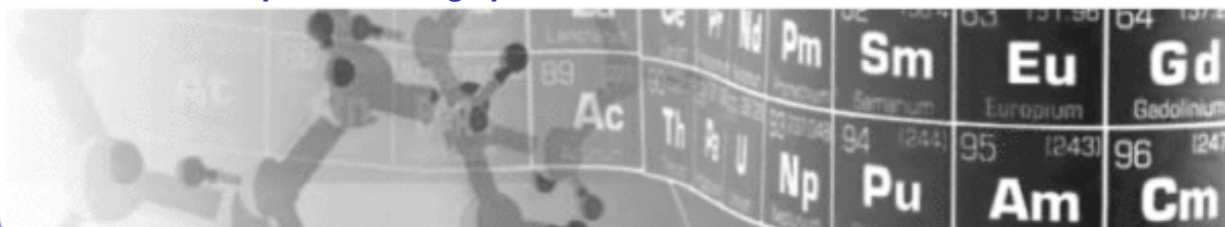

## Goals

Main goal of the *Interdivisional Group of Proteome Chemistry* is supporting and promoting the role of Chemistry in the field of Proteome Science. ## Institution
