1. Essay Submission

- a. Submissions will be accepted beginning November 22, 2018 00:01 am GMT through January 31, 2019 00:00 pm CET.
- b. Essays must be submitted via email to scicultura@gmail.com.
- c. Essays must be in English and 1000 words in length, with maximum one picture.
- d. The winning essays will be uploaded to ChemistryViews.org and to Italian Chemical Society website.

2. Judging

- a. Winners will be determined by the panel of judges listed below. They will select two winners from all submitted essays after submission.
